



Volunteer Checklist

It is extremely important that all volunteers take these crucial steps prior to traveling with HFF. Please complete all of the tasks below in order to have a safe, fun, and successful volunteer experience!

Passports:

Renew or apply for a US passport online or at your local post office. Your passport must be valid through the dates of your travel until you arrive back in the US.

Complete the HFF liability Waiver:

View and complete the liability waiver posted on the “Go & Serve” portion of the HFF volunteer website. This must be signed and turned in before you can legally travel and serve alongside us.

Vaccinations:

You must be fully vaccinated for the region of East Africa before you can serve with us.

You must be vaccinated for:

- Hepatitis A
- Typhoid
- Yellow fever (required)
- *Get Malaria prescription (required)

Your local practitioner or travel clinic will help direct you to multiple options and vaccinations. Please research the vaccinations and prices that will suite you best.

Register with the US embassy in Uganda:

Register with the US embassy in Uganda through the Link Below. Register your dates of travel in order to have US support in the slightest case of Emergency.
